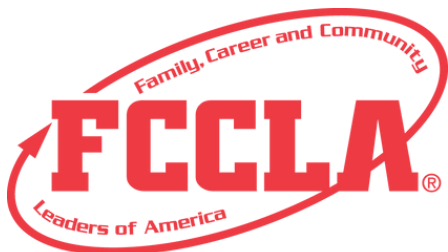
Georgia FCCLA

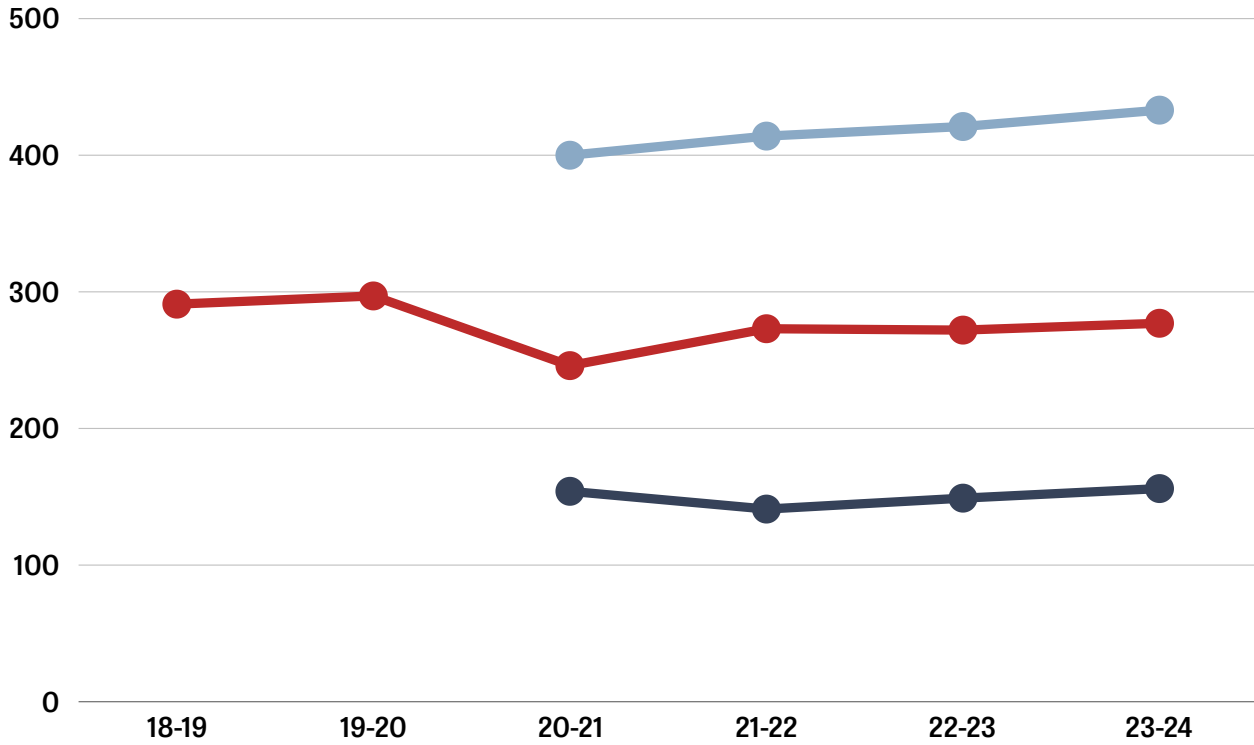
As of May 23rd, 2024, National FCCLA has **242,302** affiliated chapter members.

Regular Affiliation - \$13 per chapter member and adviser. \$9 to Nationals / \$4 to Georgia

Post-Secondary Affiliation - \$19 per chapter member and adviser. \$15 to Nationals / \$4 to Georgia.

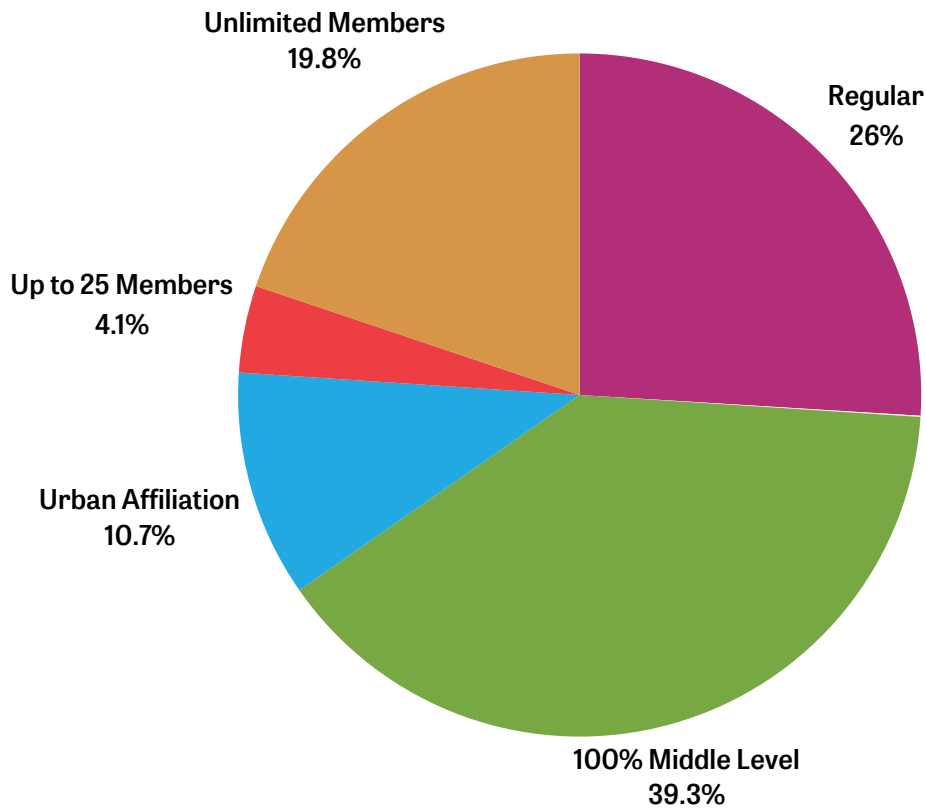
100% Middle Level - \$400 for unlimited affiliation for a chapter with members Grade 9 or lower.

Urban Affiliation - \$6,000 for unlimited affiliation for school districts within the corporate limits of a city with a population of 100,000+ can enroll and must be approved by National and Georgia FCCLA.

Up to 25 Members Affiliation - \$495 for the chapter affiliation for 25 members. \$395 to Nationals / \$100 to Georgia.

Unlimited Members Affiliation - \$1,115 for the total chapter affiliation. \$775 to Nationals / \$340 to Georgia

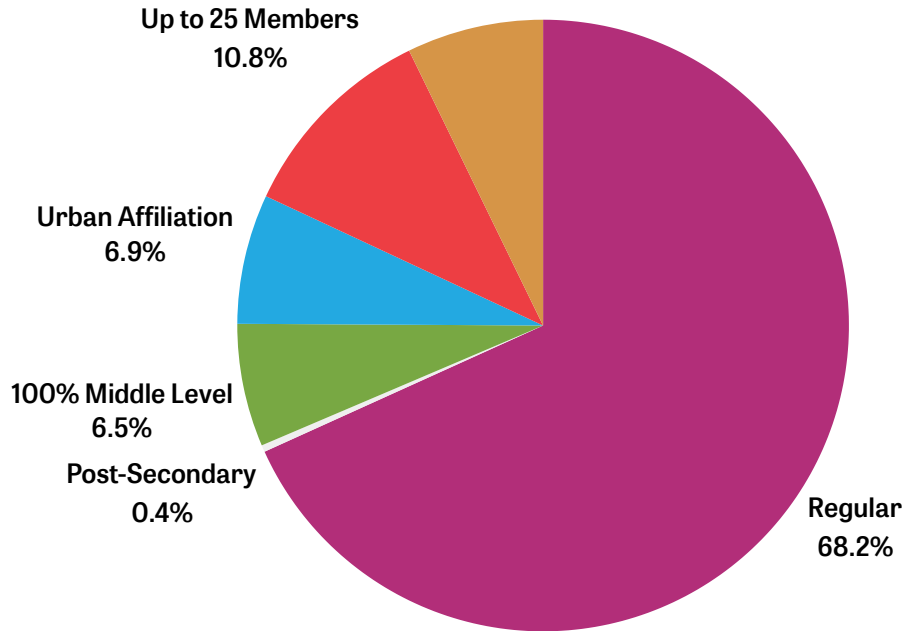
Affiliation by Membership Type



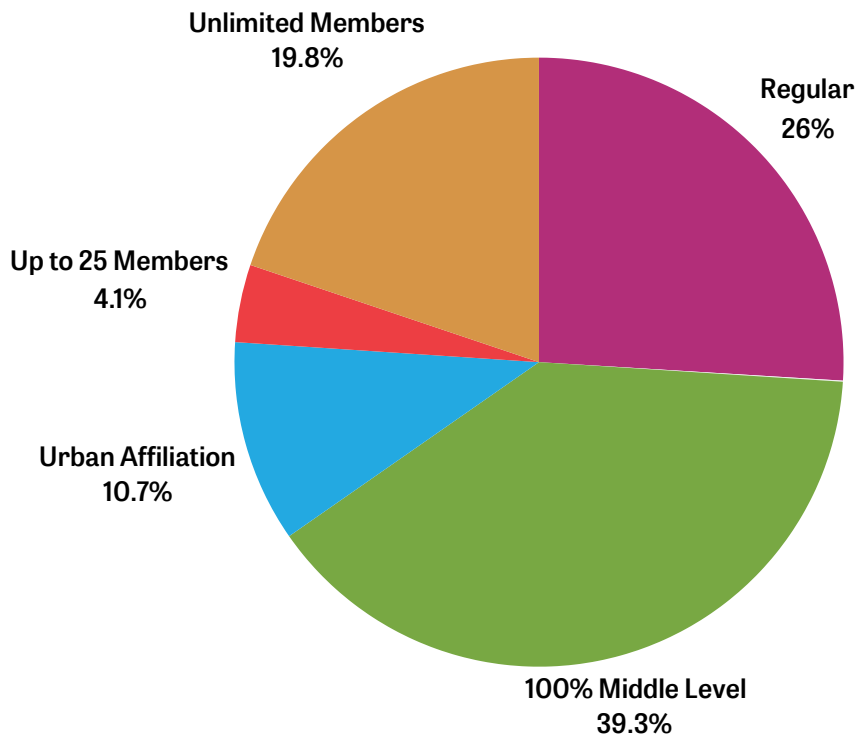

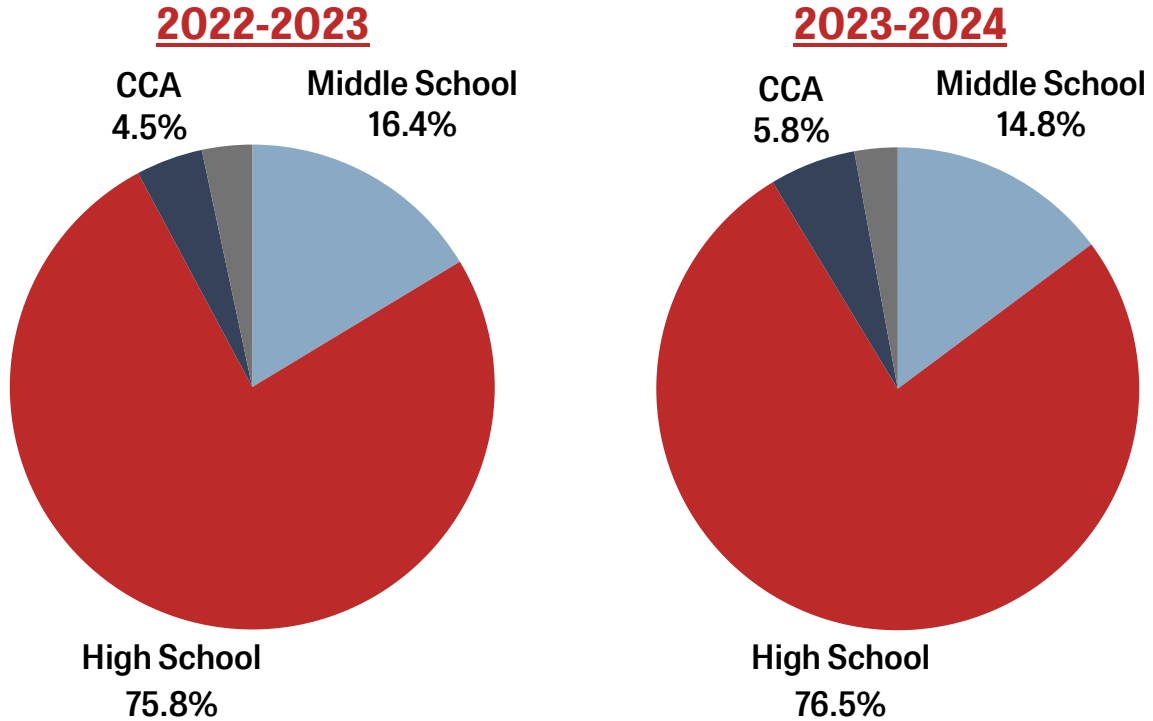

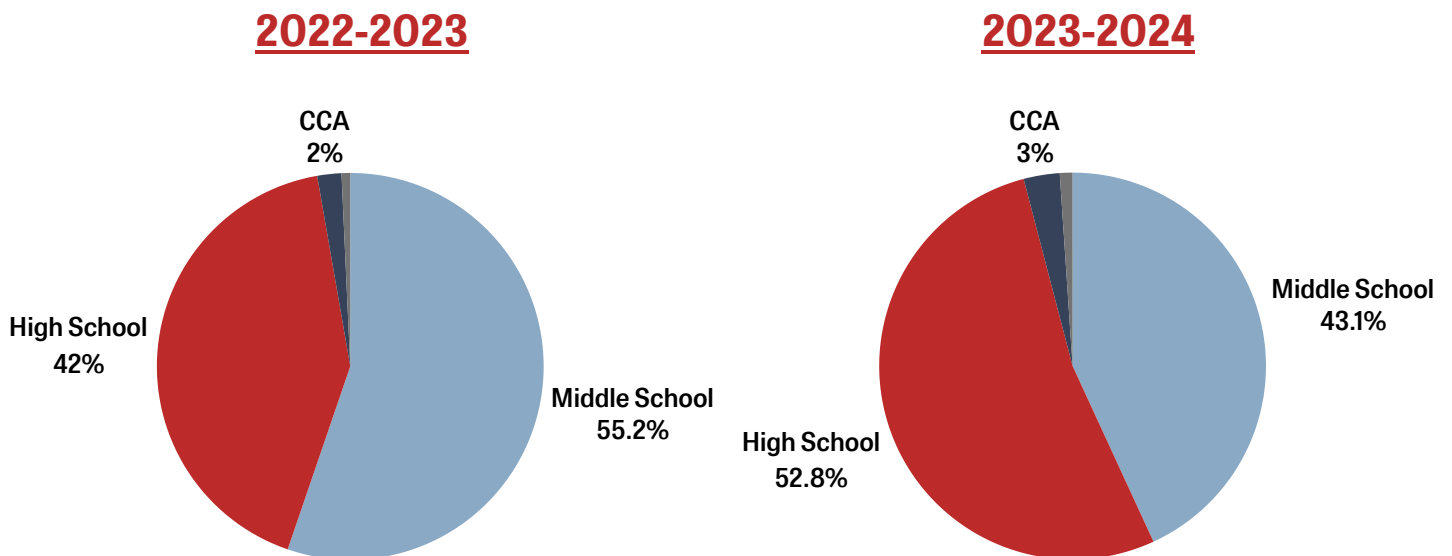


Affiliated Chapters - School Type

Affiliated Chapters - School Type - Number of Chapters



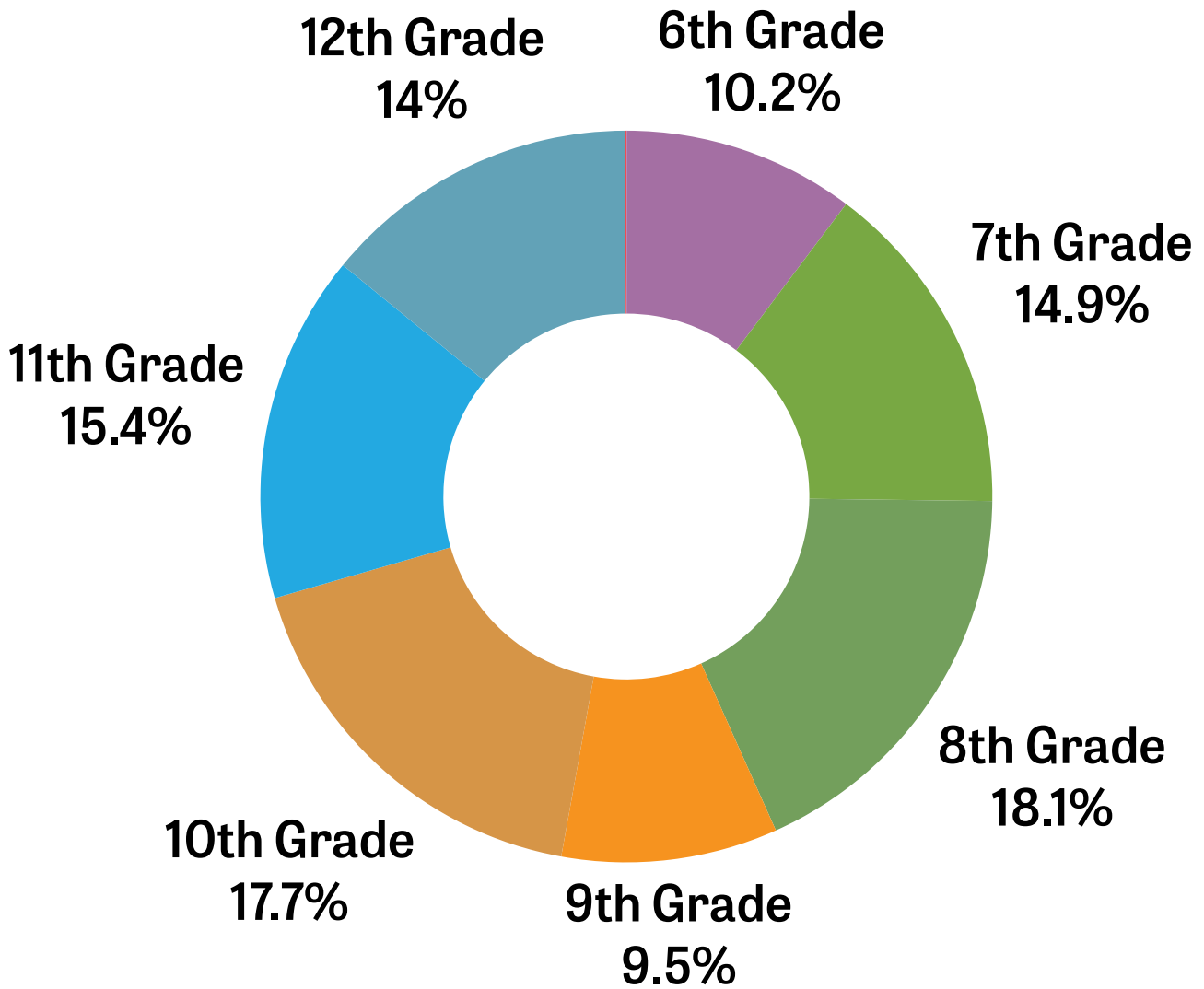

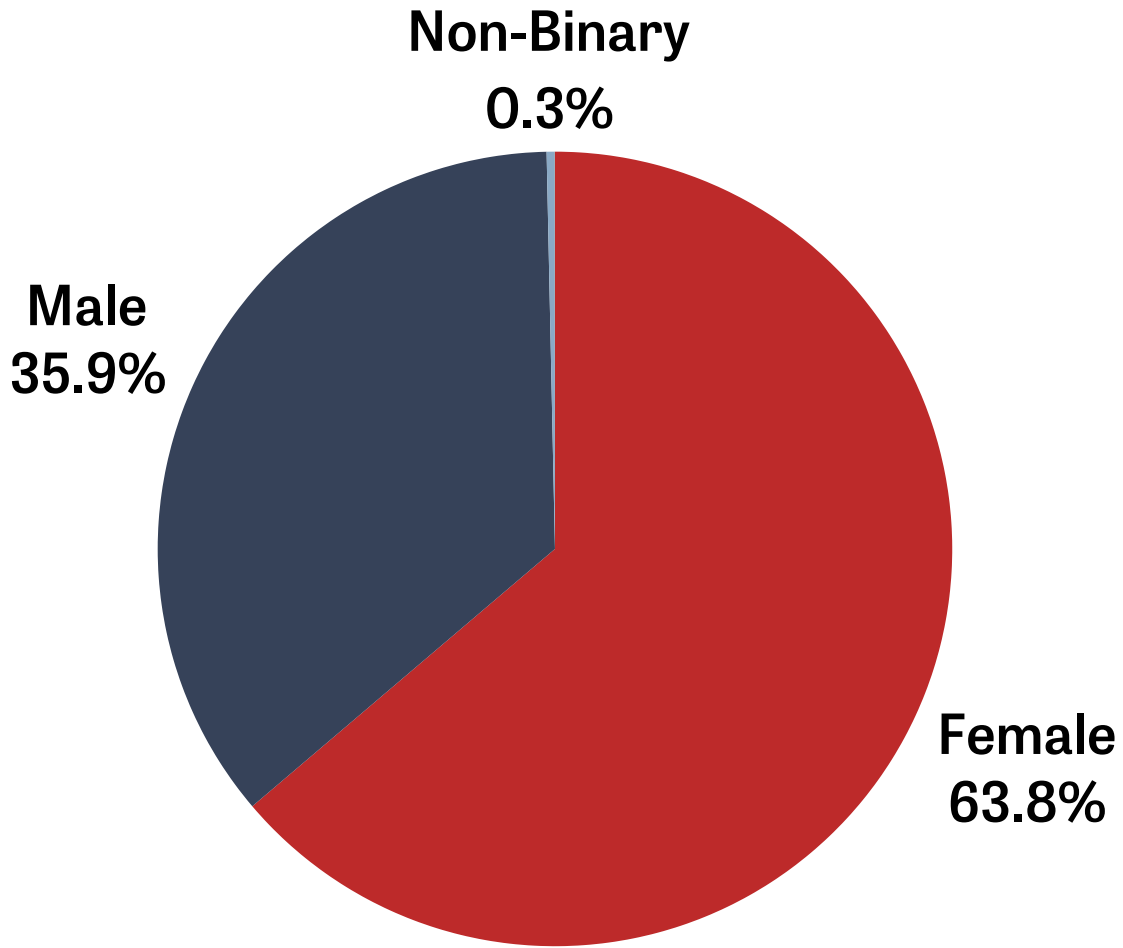

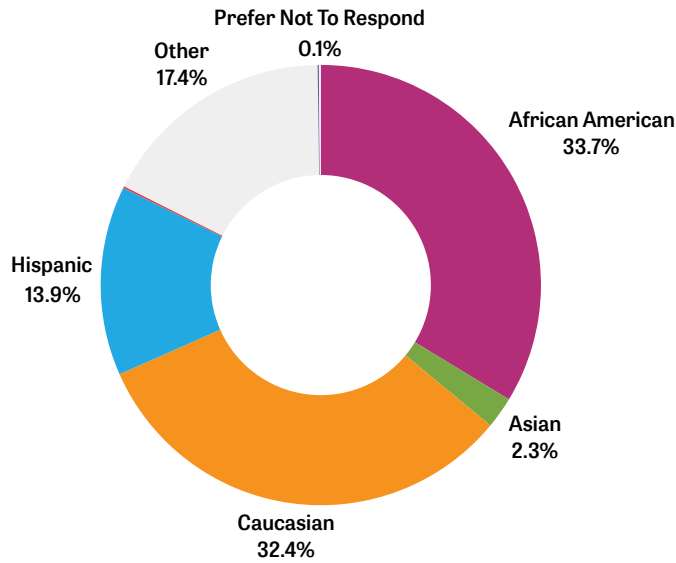

Affiliation by Gender



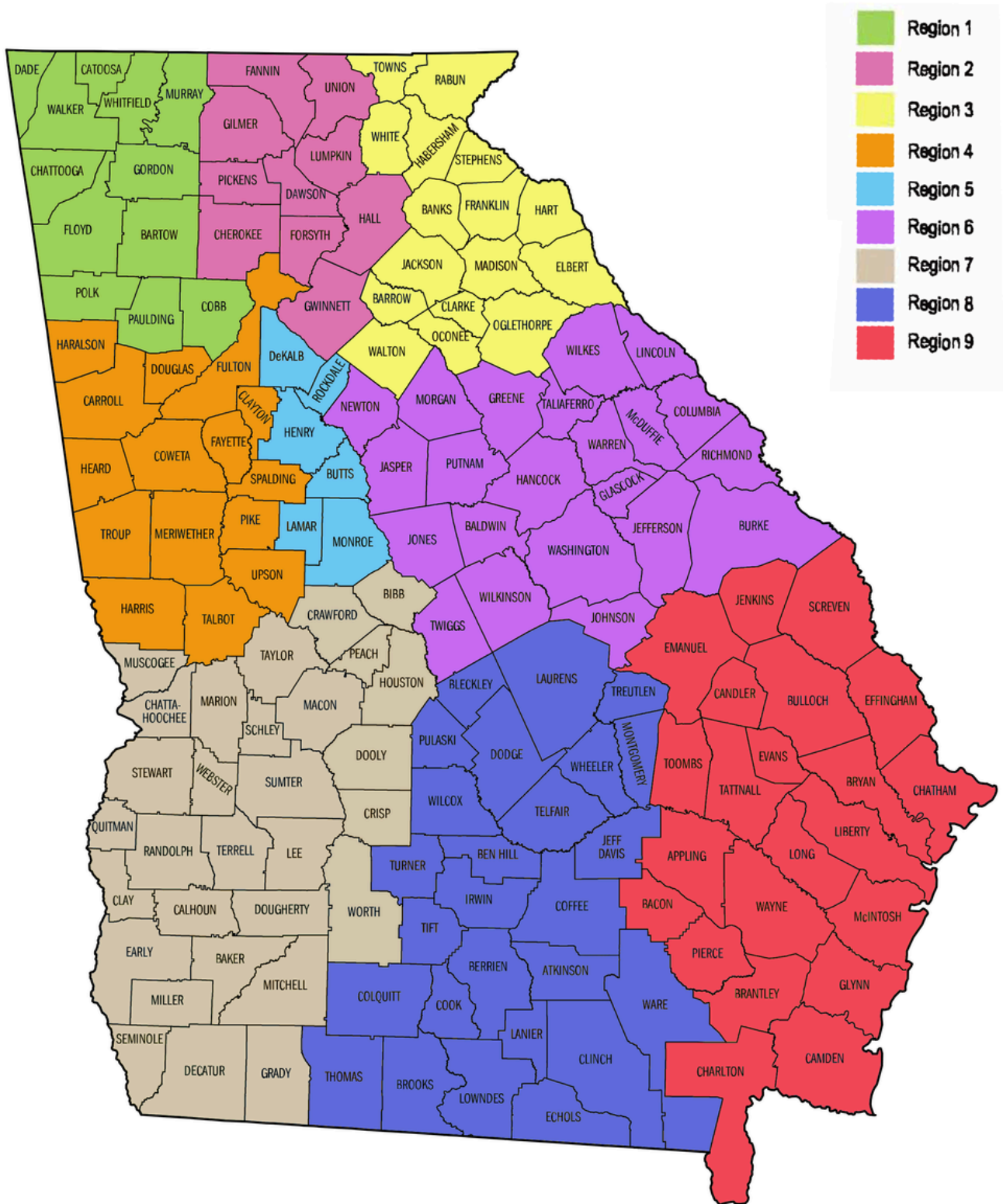

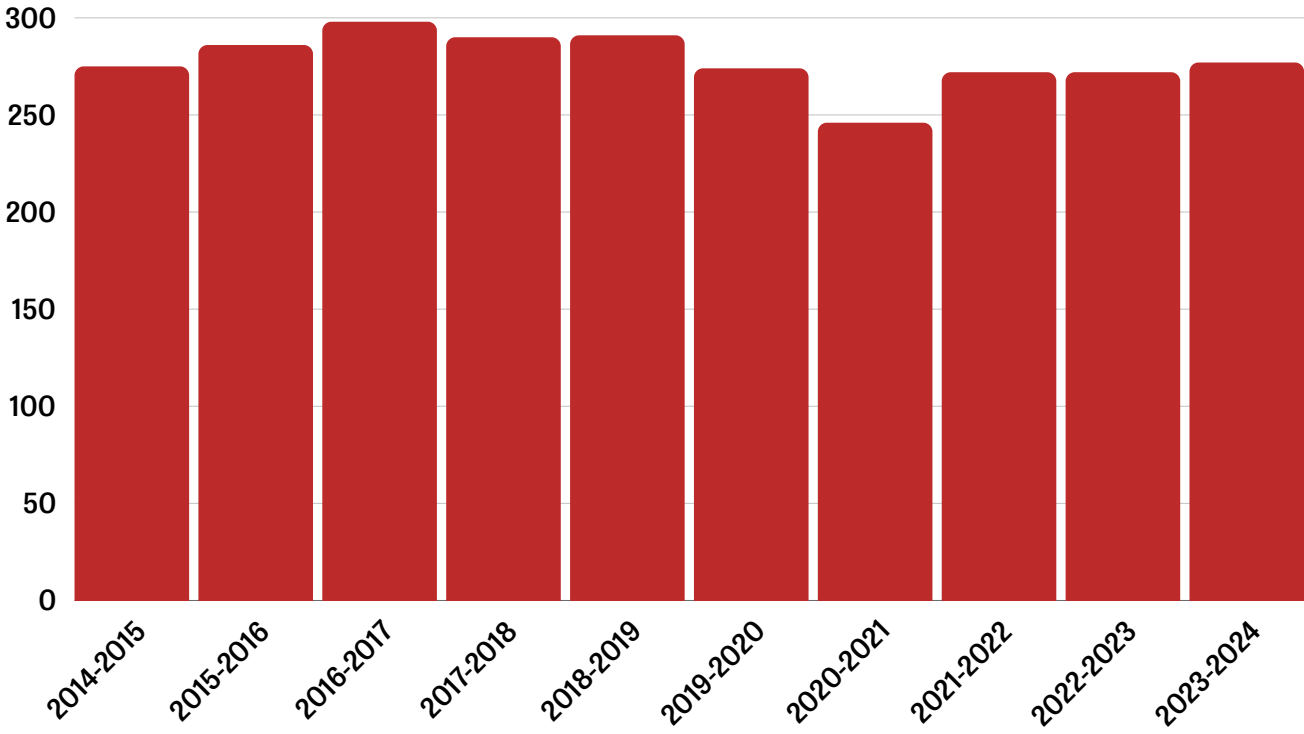

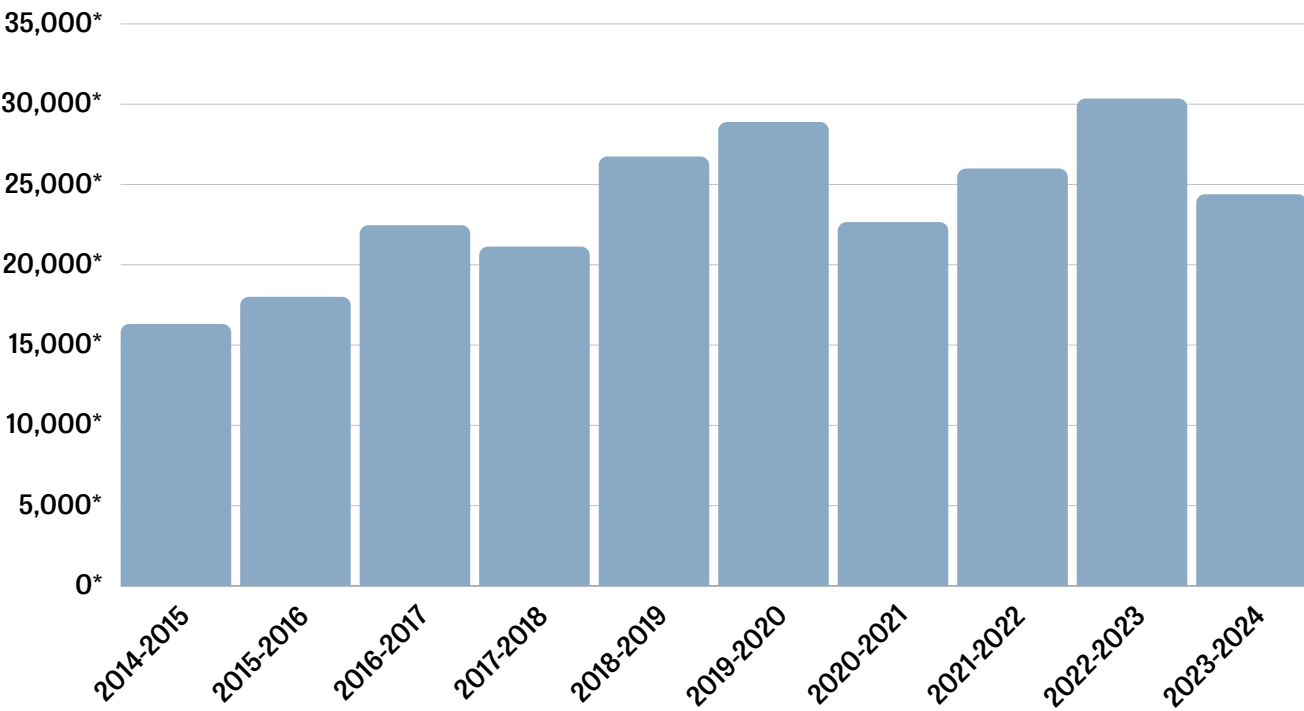
